e.g.: Mary Smith, ID Number: 1234560789; Sample **CVS Username:** [cvs-msmith789](#)

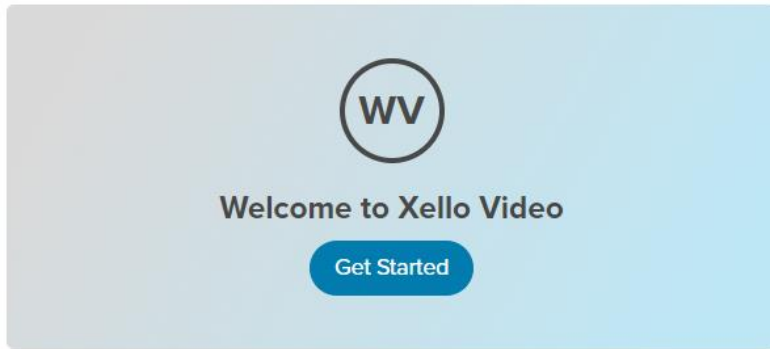

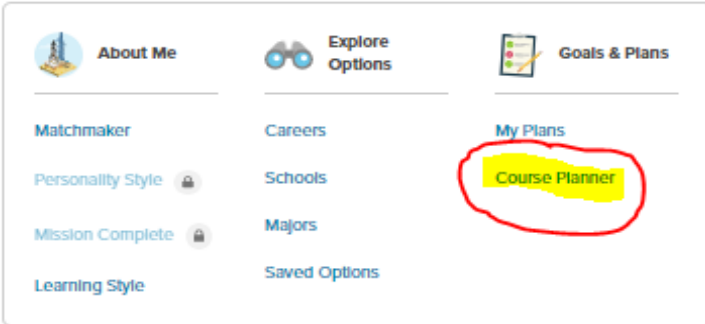


# Viewing Course Planner as a Student
