1. Register your Child by visiting [www.getmovinfundhub.com](http://www.getmovinfundhub.com), It's free, easy, and fast to register! For School Identifier use **5d78ee6dcbac5**. Your child will receive a Reading Spirit Tag + Ojibwa water bottle sticker for registering.
2. Email and/ or text your child's student fundraising webpage to 10-15 friends and family members. It's super easy!
3. Post on Facebook. The average parent has 300 FB friends. You'll be surprised when donations come in from distant relatives/friends /co-workers. Post and see what happens!
4. Help your child track their reading minutes on their FundHub profile to go towards incentives! (*see back of this sheet for incentive details*)

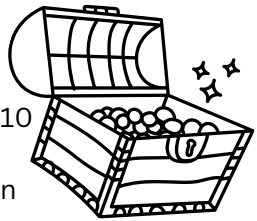

## How to track minutes read on FundHub.



1. You must have your student's account created on FundHub (see first page for how to do that)
2. Once your student's profile is completed, log in to your FundHub and you will see your Parent Dashboard.
3. There is a purple box "Minutes Read Log", click on that box.
4. It will bring you to your student's reading log. To add their minutes, click on the green box in the upper right hand corner that says "Add"
5. You can add their time as often as you'd like or every week, just make sure you are logging to have your student's efforts go towards their individual reading incentives and classroom and/or grade level incentives!
